Welcome to the 2022 Lancaster Regional! We hope you have a rewarding and enjoyable time. If you have any questions or requests, ask a member of the committee.

HEALTH & SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

ACBL guidelines will be followed, requiring all tournament attendees and staff to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19. "Fully vaccinated" means it has been at least two weeks since receiving the second Pfizer or Moderna shot, or since receiving a single-dose CDC-approved vaccine. *There are absolutely no exceptions.*

Do not miss out - be prepared:

- **Bring proof of vaccination;** it is required for entrance to the playing site.
- Safety coordinator staff will be ready to welcome you an hour before game time to check vaccination cards and I/Ds. Once your fully-vaccinated status is verified, you will be given a wristband to wear for your time at the Lancaster Regional. This wristband must be worn each day and at all times in the playing area.
- Lastly, bring masks to the tournament in the event the local transmission rate changes to "High." Also, mask wearing will be required (no questions asked) if another player requests they be worn while at their table.

PARTNERSHIP DESK

The Partnership Desk will be open daily starting one hour before 1st & 2nd session game times. Please check in as early as possible (at least 30 minutes prior to game time) to increase the chances of making pairings and allow time for potential partners to discuss styles and systems.

OUR POLICIES

ZERO TOLERANCE: The ACBL Zero Tolerance (ZT) Policy is in effect throughout the tournament. All players and participants are expected to behave in accordance with this policy at all times towards their partners, opponents, directors, caddies, tournament officials, and hotel staff. A director should be called immediately to handle any breaches of ZT, the rules, or code of ethics.

Examples of commendable behavior under ZT include being a good host and guest at the table. Unacceptable behaviors include: badgering, rudeness, intimidation, profanity, threats, or violence; negative comments about the opponents' bidding or play; gloating; constant, unwelcome, or gratuitous lessons or analysis; disruptive arguments with the directors; and ringing cell phones.

Recorder forms are available from a director or in the tournament office to submit a record of unacceptable behavior. Jess Stuart is the District 4 Recorder.

ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT: Any electronic equipment must be kept in silent mode (except for health-related equipment, where silent mode is unavailable or could constitute a health risk). While at the table, players may not use or interact with their electronic devices during bridge play. When between rounds or sitting out, use or interaction with electronic devices is permitted, provided it is inaudible. These rules apply to all players, captains, coaches and kibitzers.

SMOKING AND SCENTS: Smoking is prohibited inside the hotel and event facility, including any rooms, restrooms, restaurants, and playing areas. All smoking must be done at least 25 feet from any building entrance. Directors will assess penalties for lateness to any player who delays the start of a round or match due to a “smoke break.”

The Lancaster Regional is fragrance free. Please refrain from wearing any of the following: cologne, after shave lotion, perfume, perfumed hand lotion, fragranced hair products, and/or similar products when participating in our tournaments. Fragrances can cause serious health issues for some players.
