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#### **THE KING OF PRUSSIA TOWN CENTER**

It is about 2 miles away and is home to a dozen or so varied restaurants. Most have outdoor dining options and you can stroll after dinner! (It's also the home of the great Wegman's Supermarket.) Here are some of those spots:

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## **MORE FOOD THOUGHTS FROM THE TOURNAMENT TEAM:**

We frequent Plaza Azteca (large Mexican food portions, big Margaritas), Seasons 52 (a true favorite) and Peppers (just a short walk away with good Italian food, pizza and drink). There's a legit Starbucks just past Wild Rice (Asian and sushi) a short walk away and across from the Wawa convenience store with lots of grocery items and take-away food.

Giant Supermarket and Trader Joe's are also very close by. Remember, the Alloy has dinner service at the bar or tables surrounding it, and room service as well. And, if you want a great "Philly" steak sandwich or hoagie, head to or call Franzone's (they deliver from about 2 miles away).

For fast food, McDonald's, Burger King, Wendy's, Panera and Chipotle are very close.
